

# Single Domino Tournament







## **Rules for the Domino Tournament (Single Player)**

#### 1. Game Format

- Matches will be played using the Double Six Dominoes set.
- Each game is played to 100 points or a 20-minute time limit, whichever comes first.
- If the time limit is reached, the player with the **highest score** wins the match.

#### 2. Tournament Structure

- The tournament will follow a **single-elimination** or **double-elimination** format, depending on the number of participants.
- Players will compete one-on-one in each match.

### 3. Setting Up the Game

- Players draw **seven dominoes** each at the start of the game.
- The highest double (e.g., double six) starts the game. If no one has a double, the dominoes are reshuffled, and players draw again.
- The remaining dominoes form the **boneyard** for players to draw from during the game.

#### 4. Gameplay Rules

- Players take turns laying tiles that match one of the open ends of the domino chain.
- If a player cannot make a move, they must draw from the boneyard until a valid tile is found or the boneyard is empty.
- The round ends when:
  - A player places their last tile.
  - The game is blocked (neither player can make a move).

## 5. Scoring

- Points are scored when the total of the open ends equals a multiple of 5 (e.g., 5, 10, 15, etc.).
- At the end of a round, the winner adds the total points of the opponent's remaining tiles to their score.
- If the game is blocked, the player with the **lowest total of unplayed tiles** wins the round and scores points from their opponent's unplayed tiles.

#### 6. Rules of Conduct

- Players must exhibit good sportsmanship.
- Trash-talking is allowed for fun but must remain respectful. Offensive language or unsportsmanlike behavior will result in disqualification.

Any disputes will be resolved by the tournament official, whose decision is final.

## 7. Winning the Tournament

- The last remaining player after all rounds will be crowned the tournament winner.
- The winner will receive \$1,000 in prizes
- \$500 Gift Card 1st Place | \$300 Gift Card 2nd Place | \$200 Gift Card 3rd Place

## 8. Check-In & Timing

- Players must check in 30 minutes before the tournament begins.
- Late arrivals may forfeit their spot in the competition.

## 9. Equipment

- Dominoes and scoreboards will be provided by the tournament organizers.
- Personal domino sets are not allowed during official matches.

## 10. Disqualifications

• Cheating, intentionally stalling the game, or displaying inappropriate behavior will result in immediate disqualification.
